Teacher and Student Expectations:

Welcome, and Thank You!

Thank you for choosing me as your piano teacher! One of the keys to a great learning experience is setting clear expectations from the start. Here's what you can count on from me:

- Preparedness: I plan each lesson in advance to make our time together focused and productive.
- Respect: I value each student's unique pace, personality, and learning style.
- Quality: I select lesson materials based on experience, positive reviews, and your preferences.
- Fun: Music should be joyful! I tailor activities to each student to keep learning engaging and enjoyable.
- Integrity: I strive to be honest, kind, and thoughtful in all my interactions. I welcome feedback and genuinely care about each student's growth.

I'm excited to be part of your musical journey—let's make it a great one!

*** As a student, you will have clear expectations set for you to make your learning experience more pleasant and effective. ***

Practice Expectations and Support:

Research consistently shows that the most significant progress happens at home through regular, focused practice. While I provide the tools and guidance to make practice effective and manageable, the responsibility to practice ultimately lies with the student. Without consistent weekly practice, learning slows significantly, and lessons lose their value—both in time and cost.

To support this, I recommend a brief 10-minute review immediately after each lesson (optional but beneficial). Students are placed into one of three weekly practice tiers—100, 120, or 150 minutes—based on age and learning style. Each student is also allowed two "get out of jail free" passes per semester for illness, travel, or other conflicts. I don't expect perfection, only honest effort.

If a student repeatedly misses practice, homework, or time tracking over an extended period, it becomes difficult to make meaningful progress. In rare cases, and only after multiple conversations and attempts to find solutions, I may recommend pausing lessons. This is never a surprise—I always communicate openly and consider each student's unique circumstances.

My goal is to help every student build consistency in a way that works for them. I understand life is busy, and I'm here to support you every step of the way.

My Practice Promise:

* I know that I get better at piano by practicing at home. * Each week, I will try my best to follow my to-do list and finish my assignments. * I will keep a good attitude during lessons and practice time. * I will also remember to write down my practice minutes on my chart or in the app and have my adult initial/text!

Reward Programs: To keep things fun and motivating, I offer a few reward systems! Students can earn a prize basket filled with favorite snacks and surprises—usually earned over 4–6 months. After that, they unlock spins on the prize wheel during lessons! There's also quarterly game days (*educational music games*!) for students who meet or exceed 100% of their monthly practice goal for that quarter.

Cartitude: A positive attitude goes a long way! I understand that learning can be frustrating at times, and I'll always support students in expressing those feelings in a healthy way.

Preparedness & Accountability: Please arrive on time and bring all materials each week. Students are responsible for logging their practice time—either in a digital app on their tablet/phone or on their written practice chart. If it's not recorded, it won't count toward rewards. At least one parent initial on the written practice charts or a text/email confirmation stating: "My child practiced X minutes this week" for the digital apps is required every week.

Barents of students under 7: sitting with your child for the first few minutes of practice can really help them stay focused and build good habits! 🧡

Makeup Lessons: I don't offer regular makeup lessons—my schedule is full and I don't teach weekends. But don't worry! If you cancel, I'll add you to a cancellation list and let you know if a spot opens. You can also join a weekly online group class in place of the missed lesson. Times vary. Please ask for the online schedule if you are interested. These are fun, creative, and a great way to connect with other students! If I ever need to cancel, you'll get one-on-one makeup based on your availability.

Summer Lessons: Summer's flexible, but here's the deal: Lessons can't be gifted or transferred once you've signed up. You can take 2 weeks off and I'll fit in 2 makeups before or after your trip—just give me a week's notice. If you'll be gone more than 2 weeks, you have two options: 1. Hold your spot by paying tuition and receive 2 makeups. 2. Pause lessons and I'll add you to the waitlist to rejoin when a spot opens.

Stopping Lessons: Life happens! If you need to stop lessons: Please give at least 2 weeks' notice. If you give notice at your last lesson of the month, a 2-week prorated tuition is due that day. If you've already paid for the month and stop mid-way, no refunds, but no future payments will be due.
